STANDING RULES OF ORDER FOR VIRTUAL ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING (AGM)

1. The AGM will be run in accordance with the Credit Union Incorporation Act, the Financial Institutions Act, the Companies Act and the KCU Rules.
2. Members are required to conduct themselves in keeping with the spirit of the Khalsa throughout the meeting.
3. Members may submit a question before or during the meeting for consideration by the Board Chair or Delegate.
4. Only voting members of KCU are entitled to ask questions and vote at the AGM.
5. On each motion or report, members may submit a question but it must be concise and related to the topic at hand.
6. A second question on the same motion or report will not be considered until all the questions submitted by members the first time have been considered.
7. Comments or questions must relate to the pending motion or report as identified in the official agenda.
8. The Chair may deem a question to be out of order or not appropriate for discussion at the AGM and an alternative channel of communication will be explored.
9. The AGM is for the purpose of translating the business of the membership of KCU. Issues of a personal nature will not be discussed or debated but may be referred to a management person in attendance for discussion and/or resolution.
10. Subject to its own Rules and the applicable Laws of the land, an AGM may adopt additional Rules of Order for its conduct, but if no additional Rules are adopted, Robert's Rules of Order (revised) shall be used.
